

# Support for Families

We are aware that across all of our communities some families will struggle more than usual at this difficult time. We have pulled together a list of venues where you may be able to access food supplies, without cost, across 3 Local Authorities.

Families / individuals will need a voucher to be able to use any of the venues listed. Vouchers are available from professionals which include **Social Workers and GPs**.

At times it may also be possible to attend the **Churches / Venues** listed and speak with someone on the site to help you access a voucher.

**The Citizens Advice Bureau** in any local authority can issue vouchers enabling individuals / families access to food supplies from the venues.

**Thirteen Housing Group** distribute vouchers. Call 0300 1111000 (Central Office) and then ask to be directed to The Neighbourhood Co-ordinator.
