Lewis is currently in Year 7 and he wanted to talk to you about coming to Outwood Ormesby

Hi my name is Lewis and I have special educational needs.

Starting secondary school was very scary for me. I didn't know anyone and only a couple of my friends from primary school were going there. Going to secondary school anyway is scary but having special educational needs makes it so much harder because you don't know where you are going to get the extra help from.

During transition I spent time in the bridge. This is where a lot of extra help is given and there are fun activities to do and the staff are really kind.

As I got further into the year I got more help in my classrooms from teachers and with extra equipment. There are always people there to talk to. I do a lot of quizzes and tests to help me keep practicing to get better at my work and these are really fun.

The main things I like about my school are;

There is always someone there to talk to if you need help, they always make time for you

There are passes available so you can leave class without having to explain to teachers about your extra needs. This is really good because its discreet and you don't have to keep telling people your personal business.

Each subject has it's own block of classrooms so you can't get lost going from lesson to lesson

The school dinners are delicious! They aren't expensive so you can have a main meal and a dessert. If you lose your lunch money or there is a problem you can go to student services for a meal ticket so you always have a meal.

I hope reading this makes you feel happier about coming to a new school!



Go onto the website of your Outwood Ormesby and have a look at our uniform. This is what my school uniform will be when I go to Outwood Ormesby:





